SPRING PET ADOPTION EXPO

Tampa, FL - The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) and No More Homeless Pets in Hillsborough County (NMHP-HC) are hosting a spring pet adoption expo May 19, 10 am - 2 pm at the Florida State Fairgrounds Special Event Building, located at 4800 Highway 301 North in Tampa.

Adults, children and families are encouraged to attend. Over 20 animal rescue Groups, as well as Hillsborough County Animal Services and the Humane Society of Tampa Bay, will be present with hundreds of dogs, cats, puppies and kittens looking for forever homes. The event also features pet merchandise, door prizes and demonstrations on topics such as disaster preparedness, pet behavior and "Ask a Veterinarian." Free parking is available using the Fairgrounds entrance on Orient Road. Admission is free. Donations are accepted.

NMHP-HC is a non-profit organization with a focus on ending homeless pet overpopulation in Hillsborough County. Nearly 30,000 animals were euthanized in 2006 due to a lack of homes. Events such as this one aim to put an end to this tragedy.

ASPCA Mission: Orange is a focused effort to create a country of humane communities, one community at a time, where animals receive the compassion and respect they deserve—a nation where there is no more unnecessary euthanasia of adoptable animals simply because of a lack of resources and awareness. Hillsborough County has been selected as a target community with a goal of increasing the save rate for homeless pets from 10 percent currently to 50 percent by the year 2010.
