- Laptop computer with access to Internet and shelter software
- Printer
- Cell phone with credit card reader app
- Cash drawer of \$100
- Donation box
- Wheeled file box
- Letter size file folders for the following contents:
 - Adoption applications
 - Adoption contracts
 - Receipts
 - New pet parent information including
 - first night success tips
 - free health voucher
 - pet health insurance information
 - ways to become involved with the shelter
 - Adoptable animal files including
 - medical history
 - behavior history and information
 - surrender/foster history
- Folding table with handle (6' long)
- Sign holders (clear plastic, 8.5 x 11")
- Cage cards or detailed signage about each animal with photos
- Side/top/front-opening animal cages
- Basic pet supplies provided to all foster caregivers including:
 - dishes for food and water
 - bedding
 - cardboard carriers
 - litter and litter pan
 - adoption vests
 - collars/harnesses
 - leashes
 - toys
