

ASPCA Cornell Maddie's Shelter Medicine Conference Area Accommodations

After you have registered for the Shelter Medicine Conference, now it's time to make your room arrangements. All attendees are responsible for making and paying for their own overnight accommodations. Here is a list of the accommodations where you can get a special conference rate. There are limited rooms available at each location, so make your reservations early.

Cornell University On-Campus Housing Accommodations

Reservations for both Townhouse Apartments and Mews Hall must be made by **July 23, 2018**, via online web portal -

Townhouse Apartments

Each Townhouse apartment can accommodate up to 4 people and has the following: Full kitchen with stove, fridge, sink, cupboard space (please note: pots, pans and utensils are not provided); Furnished living room with basic cable; shared bathroom.

Rates (per person):

- Single Bedroom in shared Townhouse (1 person per bedroom with 2 people per Townhouse) - \$90.00 per person per night plus tax
- Double Bedroom in shared Townhouse (2 people per bedroom with 4 people per Townhouse) - \$60.00 per person per night plus tax

Mews Hall

Single Bedroom (1 person per bedroom)

Bedrooms have an extra-long twin bed, desk, desk lamp, desk chair, dresser, book case, waste basket, and closet or wardrobe for each person. Each person will receive 2 sheets, 1 pillow, 1 pillow case, 2 bath towels, 1 face cloth, 1 blanket, and one bedspread. Beds will be made upon arrival. Bathrooms in Mews Hall are shared.

Rates (per person): Single Bedroom (1 person per bedroom) - \$82.00 per person per night plus tax

Please Note: Each person needing housing must register separately through this site. Prices provided are per person, per night.

If you want to share accommodations, here is how to make your roommate requests.

Step 1: Every person wanting to share a room must register individually for their on-campus housing first (see above link for registration page).

Step 2: After all potential roommates are registered for their rooms – and only after, then each of you must send an email to confserv@cornell.edu to indicate the name of the person(s) you want to share your accommodations with during the conference.

Please note: This is college housing, conveniently within walking distance to the RPCC, with some conveniences, like coffee makers, microwaves, and a full kitchen in each Townhouse. The rooms are cleaned daily or you can put out your "Do not Disturb" sign. If you lose your key, there is a charge. There is a small convenience store in the RPCC where you can purchase items for meals, if needed.

Upon Your Arrival: The Robert Purcell Conference Center is 3.5 miles from the airport. The accommodations are within walking distance to the Robert Purcell Conference Center (RPCC). When you arrive to check into your on-campus housing accommodations, go into the Service Desk, located on the 1st floor of RPCC.

On-Campus Parking:

Free Parking: Parking for the 2018 conference will be in A Lot, which is free no permit required, 2:30 pm on Friday until 7:30 am on Monday and less than a five-minute walk to the venue. If you are a Cornell Community member, you will need to register your vehicle with Transportation https://cornelltransportation.t2hosted.com/cmnauth_ext.aspx.

Other Parking: For individuals who wish to park directly outside of the Robert Purcell Community Center (CC LOT), it will be \$6 daily with the Parkmobile Pay-By-Cell Parking app. A parking permit or Parkmobile payment is required to park on campus in CC lot. Download the Parkmobile Pay-By-Cell Parking app or call 1-877-727-5730 to register for a Parkmobile account. You will need your license plate number and a method of payment (credit card or PayPal) to register. If you will be here outside of the A lot hours above, you will need to park in CC lot for that time and pay via Parkmobile.
