

Identifying Sterilized Animals

Tattoo Placement

All animals receive a linear green tattoo after their spay/neuter surgery to prevent unnecessary exploratory surgeries in the future. Green is not naturally occurring, so is therefore distinct.



A straight cut appears different than frostbite or fight wounds



Next to where an abdominal spay incision is located (or would be located, as altered male cats can be mistaken for females)

Ear-tipping

Community cats are also ear-tipped, which allows identification from a distance.
