



Watch out for Blue Green Algae!

Warm weather conditions promote the growth of **cyanobacteria**, an algae that can make your pet seriously sick!

Cyanobacteria is most likely to thrive in bodies of fresh water when the weather is **over 75** degrees and sunny.

If your pet drinks water with blue green algae they may present symptoms such as drooling, disorientation, weakness, vomiting, panting, collapse, seizures and respiratory failure, which can eventually lead to liver failure.
