
Watch out for Blue Green Algae!



The bacteria itself is **invisible** to the eye, but water may appear pea-green in color or have slime on the surface

Cyanobacteria is most likely to thrive in bodies of fresh water when the weather is **over 75** degrees and sunny.

If your pet drinks water with blue green algae they may present symptoms such as drooling, disorientation, weakness, vomiting, panting, collapse, seizures and respiratory failure, which can eventually lead to liver failure.
