

# Four on the Floor Leashing

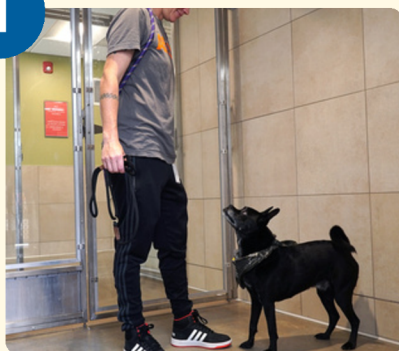


Help energetic dogs learn to stay on all fours during leashing so that taking dogs out of their kennel can be safer and easier.

Get as many people as possible to practice *Four on the Floor Leashing* every time they leash a dog. Progress may be slow at first, but consistent practice will help dogs learn which behaviors are rewarded.

**HINT:** Always take along a pouch stocked with very tasty treats!

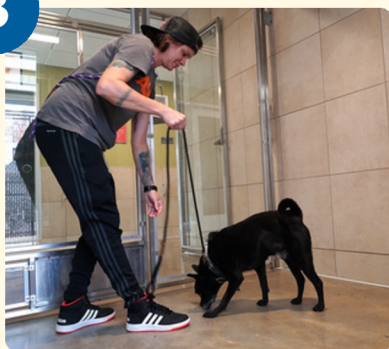
Wait for the dog to have all feet on the floor for a moment.

TIP



If the dog will not stop jumping even for a moment, calmly hold the leash in one hand and treats in the other hand, low enough so the dog must have all paws on the floor to put their head through the leash and eat the treats.
