

Native Wild Birds and Domestic Fowl

Native wild birds can legally only be treated by state licensed wildlife rehabilitators

Domestic fowl may include turkeys, chickens, geese, ducks and fighting fowl

May have to deal with larger birds such as ostrich and emus





Key Points

- Species vs. breeds
- Tame vs. domesticated
- Prey animals kept in captivity
- Selection primarily for appearance not behavior (color morphs)





Basic Avian Facts

- Larger the bird the longer they live (80+ years)
- Cognitive ability of a 2-5 year old child
- Vocalize as part of their social behavior; some learn human words and speech patterns
- High metabolic rates
- Neophobic

- Variety of cages available
- Manufactured for birds (safety & toxicity)
- Suitable for species housed
- Variety of perches, dishes and toys

Easy to clean

Nutrition



- Recognize signs of illness (hidden)
- Veterinary protocol

Breeding

- Inadvisable
- No readily available option for spay/neuter
- May lay eggs even without the presence of a mate
- Behavioral and medical implications

Placement

- Screening should be more intense than for dogs or cats
- Most people NOT familiar with care or requirements of parrots
- 3-4% of population compared to 30-40%
