| •   | AVSNC will obtain blood and run the test during the course of surgical preparation and surgery.  |    |
| •   | Shelters may opt for surgery to not be performed, based upon test results. These cats will be anesthetized prior to a blood draw, and will be shaved in preparation for surgery, but surgery will be delayed until a test result is obtained.  |    |
| •   | In the event that a shelter selects this option, and the cat tests positive, a \$15 anesthetic induction fee will be charged, along with the test charge. Additionally, if a positive result is obtained, follow-up testing is ALWAYS recommended to confirm results.  |    |
