Surgical Pack Instruments



Sterility & Packs at Spay/Neuter Clinics

There are a variety of instruments available for use in surgery. We generally use certain instruments to perform high-quality, high-volume spay/neuter surgeries and these are included in packs depending upon the species and sex of the patient:

Carmalts

Both straight and curved carmalts are clamps with longitudinal grooves that clamp across a tubular structure (such as a uterus or ovarian pedicle).

Straight



Mosquito Hemostats

Used to control bleeding and/or grip tissue.





Criles

Used to control bleeding and/or grip tissue.



Metzenbaum Scissors Surgical scissors designed for cutting delicate tissue.



Adson-Brown Forceps

Used to hold delicate tissue.



Rat Tooth Forceps Used to grasp dense tissue.



Spay Hooks

Blunt-pointed hook for exteriorizing a uterine horn during a spay operation.



Towel Clamps Used to hold surgical drapes in place.



Needle Holders

Used as a combination instrument for driving the needle and then cutting the suture without changing instruments.
