

Is the pet stable?

- Vitals are WNL, no tremors or seizures

if so, proceed...

Signalment

- Breed _____
- Age _____
- Weight _____

Health History

- Any health issues? (History of seizures, heart problems, IBD or sensitive stomach, recent surgeries, etc.)

- Is the pet currently on any medications or supplements?

- Is he on heartworm or flea prevention? Herbal supplements?

(Note: The question “Is he on any regular medication” may trigger a response when other questions won’t)

Agent Information

- Verify full name of product

- EPA registration number (if chemical or insecticide)

- Active ingredients and concentration or mg strength

Exposure Information

- How long ago was the exposure?

(Helpful questions if owner has trouble with this: when did you leave the house and come back? Was the package still wet when you found it?)

- Is any packaging missing?

- What is the worst-case scenario about how much could be missing?

- How big was the container to begin with?

- Are any pills left? Intact or chewed?

- When was the prescription filled; how many pills were prescribed?

- Is anything left on the floor or in the container?

- Are there any other pets in the house? Can they be ruled out?
(Were they crated or physically unable to reach the item?)

Clinical signs

- **Vomiting**

- Did the pet vomit independently or something given to induce?

- If something was given, what and how much?

- Is there any evidence of toxin in the vomit?

- How many times has the pet vomited?

- Is there any blood in the vomitus?

Was food and/or water offered between bouts of vomiting?

When was the last time the pet vomited?

• **Shaking**

Is the shaking constant (tremors) or does the pet seem cold or nervous and the shaking gets better and worse?
