Content to Include in Posts

The promotion guide includes graphics and images to include in posts to your social media pages. We also encourage sharing photos of available animals, of newly adopted animals with their new families, and other photos of your shelter/rescue.

Please keep in mind that the posts below are suggested and can be altered and updated as much or as little as you would like. We encourage posting as often as possible to help spread the word!

Be sure to always use the hashtag so that your post will be included on ASPCA's Find Your Fido social media feed. By using the hashtag on Instagram, you will also have a chance to be featured on The Dodo's Instagram account (nearly 4 million followers).

Be sure to include photos or videos in posts whenever possible to boost engagement.

Ways to Use Your Fido Chalkboard on Social Media

Push their Personality: Share tidbits about the dog's personality/what they're looking for in a new home. This should be fun and play to the dog's quirks!





Tell a Story: Go Live on Facebook or Instagram and use your chalkboard to tell the story of a dog in need. <u>Here's an example</u> of how we used cue cards for a similar activation with a cute St. Patrick's Day spin!

Name their Needs: Is there some important info an adopter should know? Use your chalkboard to highlight these facts to make sure they find the right home (ex. "I'm a senior dog", "I have a medical condition", "I was rescued from a bad situation", etc.).

Happy Tails: Your followers will be thrilled to see your success stories as well! Use your chalkboard to add some cute commentary to an adoption photo with Fido's new family (ex. "I've met my match", "I <3 my new family", etc.) and really melt some hearts.

Promote your Event: Share photos of adoptable dogs leading up to your event with more info on your chalkboard (ex. "5 days 'til our #FindYourFido event", "Come meet me today!" etc.)

Track your Progress: Throughout the month, use your chalkboard to count adoptions, or do a countdown from your target goal.

FAQ

Q: How do we encourage social sharing and participation?

A: Utilize your tools! Set up a photo opp with your Fido chalkboard in the most visible area of your adoption center to draw attention and encourage visitors to post a photo to social media. Be sure that the #FindYourFido hashtag is especially obvious and that you include your shelter's social media handle/profile as well, so you can track any photos from your event. This is a great opportunity for new adopters to snap their first photo with a Fido of their very own! More importantly, get engaged with your audience! Jump into any social conversation around the campaign and try to be a resource to answer questions from the community. Be sure to share, retweet and regram any photos taken at your shelter with the #FindYourFido hashtag as well to show your appreciation!

Q: What are some attention-grabbing social media tactics?

A: At the ASPCA, we definitely see the most attention on "Live" content. When you go live on Facebook or Instagram, your followers will automatically receive a push notification to tune into your video. Live videos see 3X the engagement of traditional video shares on the platform, and your followers can engage with your content in real-time through questions, comments, and shares!

Q: What kind of time limit should be put on video segments? Is it better to have multiple animals in a segment or just concentrate on one or two?

A: This depends on your content! If you're posting a pre-recorded video, keep it short and sweet (a minute or so is ideal!) Many users quickly scroll through their news feeds, so try to open with some compelling imagery to hook their attention before they can scroll by.





If you're going Live, take your time! This gives your followers a better chance to tune in during the action. At the ASPCA, we love setting up puppy playtimes for live video – these usually last 20 minutes or so and make for great engagement. Who doesn't love puppies?

Q: How do you make social media effective to gaining not only new audiences but getting them to come in the door?

A: An easy way to bring an online campaign to life is by setting up a Facebook event. If you're hosting a #FindYourFido adoption event, be sure to create the event as soon as possible so that you can start spreading the word throughout the month. Invite all of your friends and followers and ask them to share the event to their networks as well!

Most importantly: show, don't tell. Use social media as a platform to bring your shelter or rescue to your followers through imagery, video and frequent updates - keep them in the loop whenever you have new animals available, events, or volunteering opportunities. The more you can stay front-of-mind for your community, the better!

Q: What kind of pictures draw the most attention?

A: Absolutely anything animal related! Try to always include an animal in photos and video, even if the focus is on a staff member of volunteer. Videos are even better – get those tails wagging and cameras rolling.

Q: I don't have time to manage social media full-time. Can I schedule my posts?
