

• 9 weeks to 5 months


Adult

• 5 months and older




90% of the kittens under 5 months of age come in during "Kitten Season"

LA Feline Shelter Population by Ages




LA Portions of Feline Euthanasia

An effort to help animal welfare organization grow their local foster networks and take some of the kitten-season burden off staff's shoulders.






