

Outcome Terms	
Return to owner (RTO)	Animals included in shelter Intake count (current or prior reporting period) who are successfully reunited with their owners (i.e. reclaimed from shelter).
Adoption	Final adoptions only. Does not include animals placed in foster care, on overnight 'trial' stays, or on hold at shelter prior to completion of adoption agreement.
Return to Field	Stray felines included in shelter Intake (current or a prior month), altered and returned to stray capture location as free-roaming felines.
Transfer - partners	Animals sent to other agencies or organizations that are "Dashboard-reporting" partners.
Transfer – non-partners	Animals transferred to agencies that guarantee placement and are not "Dashboard-reporting" partners .
Euth – owner-requested	Narrow category that should only include animals that were brought to the facility specifically for a low cost euthanasia option. Animals relinquished for adoption that are deemed "unadoptable" by the partner agency should not be included here.
Euth – all other [reasons]	Animals euthanized for all reasons EXCEPT owner-requested.
Died in care	Animals in the agency's care that die (cause is NOT euthanasia) during their stay (in shelter or foster).
Lost in Care	Animals lost while in agency's care (e.g., escape from foster home).

Targeted S/N [by animal type, other than TNR]	Only S/N conducted on <u>owned</u> animals. Does not include shelter animals (or from partner shelters, non-partner shelters, rescue groups, etc) altered before adoption, or cats or kittens altered through a TNR program.
TNR (Trap, Neuter, Release)	Surgery count for stray,feral and/or free-roaming felines returned to a colony or other source location post- surgery. Does not include owned animals or shelter cats or kittens who will not be returned to a colony. It DOES include felines taken into the Shelter, counted as intake and then altered and Released to the Field.

Number of Permanent cages	This number only includes cages that are permanent in the facility. Do not include cage banks that are wheeled out to handle overflow or condos that are set up throughout the facility.
Number of Group Housing Units	Some facilities have designed colony housing for cats, or dog suites designed to house more than one animal at a time. List the number of these units available, and the number of animals each were designed to hold. Note: "T" or Guillotine style dog kennels should be counted as one kennel run.
Dog shelter capacity (#)	The number of permanent cages for dogs (each counted as Capacity =1).
Cat shelter capacity (#)	The number of permanent cages (each counted as 1) + (the number of group housing units X the number of animals each is designed to hold).
# of active foster homes	Number of foster homes with at least one animal in them on the last day of the month. Offsite adoption locations such as PetSmart should also be counted as foster homes - each cage space counts as one foster home.
End actual – in shelter	The number of animals by report group (e.g., dogs, puppies, cats, kittens) in shelter (excluding those animals in foster care) on the last day of the reporting month.

Difference	The difference between the reported total end count and the calculated end count. Calculation: prior months' end count (as reported), plus current month intake, minus current month outcomes. Any "difference" number not equal to zero means there is an error in one or more of the intake/outcome numbers or an end count(s).
Shelter dogs as % capacity	The Total Dog adult equivalent in shelter divided by the dog shelter capacity #
Shelter cats as % capacity	The Total Feline adult equivalent in shelter divided by the feline shelter capacity#
Foster as % capacity	Total animals reported as "in foster" divided by # of active foster homes
Dog adult equivalent in shelter	# dogs + (# puppies/2.5) For example: 2 dogs and 3 puppies would be equal to 2+(3/2.5) = 3.2 dog adult equivalents.
