- Vomiting of infectious origin
- Common skin disorders
- Urinary tract infections

Not included: Emergency and Specialty veterinary services are not part of our complimentary care.

No coverage is offered for treatment of parvo virus, FIP, Feline Leukemia, FIV, Distemper, hepatitis and ringworm.

**Medical Services are covered up to \$250 during the first 14-days after adoption. This offer only applies to the qualifying adopted dog or cat and not any other animals. This certificate has no cash value and is void should you select another veterinary hospital for initial examination of your adopted pet.
