

Vaccination Recommendations for Shelter Cats

Vaccine	Adult Cats (<i>>20 weeks old</i>)	Kittens (<i>4-20 weeks old</i>)	Where to Administer	Notes
<p>Modified live virus Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis,* Calicivirus, Panleukopenia (FVRCP)</p> <p>*This is the same as Herpesvirus-1</p>	<p>Administer one dose at or prior to intake. Administer a second dose 2-3 weeks later.</p>	<p>Administer one dose at or prior to intake. Administer additional doses every 2-3 weeks until the kitten is 20 weeks old.</p>	<p>Subcutaneous, right forelimb</p>	<p>Intranasal FVRCP vaccines may be given simultaneously, but should not be given in place of injectable panleukopenia vaccines.</p>
<p>Rabies</p>	<p>Administer one dose either on intake or prior to exit.</p>	<p>Administer one dose at legal age (>12 weeks) either on intake or prior to exit.</p>	<p>Subcutaneous, right hindlimb</p>	<p>Administration of rabies vaccine is directed by state or local law.</p>
