

Vaccination Recommendations for Shelter Cats

Vaccine	Adult Cats (>20 weeks old)	Kittens (4-20 weeks old)	Where to Administer	Notes
Modified live virus Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis,* Calicivirus, Panleukopenia (FVRCP)	Administer one dose at or prior to intake. Administer a second dose 2-3 weeks later.	Administer one dose at or prior to intake. Administer additional doses every 2-3 weeks until the kitten is 20 weeks old.	Subcutaneous, right forelimb	Intranasal FVRCP vaccines may be given simultaneously, but should not be given in place of injectable panleukopenia vaccines.
*This is the same as Herpesvirus-1				
Rabies	Administer one dose either on intake or prior to exit.	Administer one dose at legal age (>12 weeks) either on intake or prior to exit.	Subcutaneous, right hindlimb	Administration of rabies vaccine is directed by state or local law.
