Area Accommodations



**2019 ASPCA® Cornell Maddie's®
Shelter Medicine Conference**

July 12-14, 2019 — Cornell University

All attendees are responsible for making and paying for their own overnight accommodations including any incidental charges or other fees incurred during your stay. Ithaca offers a variety of housing and hotel options. Below is a list of the accommodations where a special conference rate has been secured for attendees. There are limited rooms available at each location, so make your reservations early.

CORNELL UNIVERSITY ON-CAMPUS HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS

Attendees of the ASPCA® Cornell Maddie's® Shelter Medicine Conference may stay in Townhouse Community (all are shared accommodations) located across from Robert Purcell Community Center on North Campus, approximately 1.5 miles from the College of Veterinary Medicine, where the conference will take place. Reservations for the Townhouse Apartments must be made by **June 20, 2019**, via [online web portal](#).

Please note that pets are not allowed in campus housing, unless they are service animals.

Each Townhouse apartment can accommodate up to 4 people and has the following:

- Full kitchen with stove, fridge, sink, cupboard space (please note: pots, pans and utensils are not provided. Kitchen kits may be signed out at the Service Desk.)
- Furnished living room
- 1 Shared bathroom for all roommates per townhouse

Townhouse Apartment Rates (per person):

- Single Bedroom in shared Townhouse (1 person per bedroom with 2 people per Townhouse) - \$90.00 per person per night plus tax & administrative fee
- Shared Bedroom in shared Townhouse (2 people per bedroom with 4 people per Townhouse) - \$60.00 per person per night plus tax & administrative fee

Accommodations also include:

- The bedroom space will have an extra-long twin bed, desk, desk lamp, desk chair, dresser, book case, waste basket, closet or wardrobe for each person.
- Each person will receive 2 sheets, 1 pillow, 1 pillow case, 2 bath towels, 1 face cloth, 1 blanket, and one bedspread. The bed will be made upon arrival and made daily.

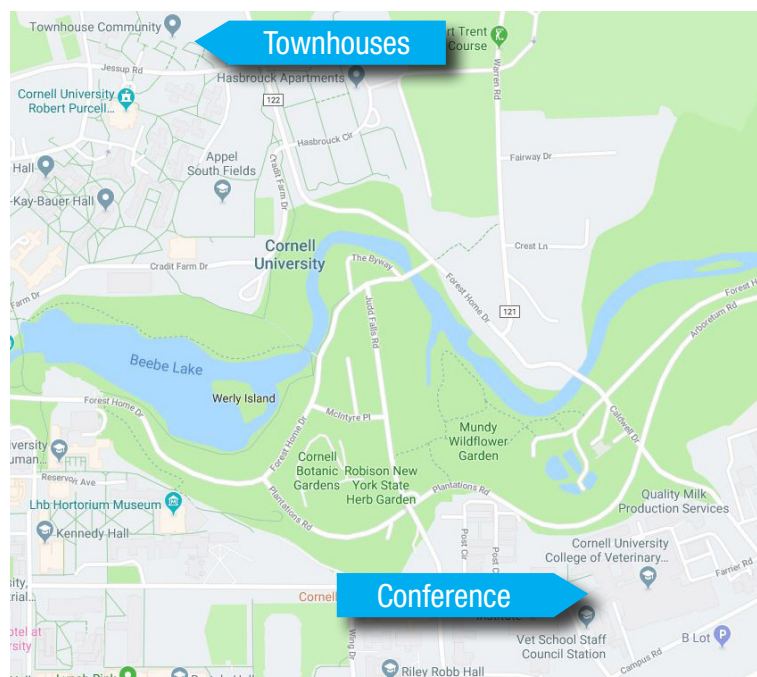
Please Note: Each person needing housing will need to register separately through the web portal. (You must log out of the portal and your browser completely between registrants- do not use your browser's back button.) Prices are per person, per night.

Roommates:

If you are requesting a specific roommate/s, all in the party must be registered for on-campus housing and request their roommate through this form or submit your rooming request to confserv@cornell.edu. Attempts will be made to honor roommate requests, but cannot be guaranteed. If you are requesting a shared room or townhouse and do not request a specific roommate, you will be placed with another conference guest of the same gender.

Tax Exempt?

Arrival and Check-in:

To check into your on-campus housing accommodations, go to Cornell's Robert Purcell Conference Center (217 Jessup Road), and proceed to the Service Desk, located on the 1st floor. The accommodations are within walking distance to the Robert Purcell Conference Center. Check-in begins at 2:00 pm on July 11, 2019. Check-out is by 10:00 a.m. on July 15, 2019. No late departures can be accommodated. Staff will be on-call for late arrivals (after 11:00 pm please call 607-255-2288).

Parking:

Parking near housing in A Lot is available for an additional fee. Parking is available for free beginning at 5:00 pm Friday. Download the app or call 1-877-727-5730 to register for a Parkmobile account; you will need your license plate number and a method of payment (credit card or PayPal). Transportation from Townhouse Apartments to the Conference:

The Townhouse Community is located about 1.5 miles from the College of Veterinary Medicine where the conference will take place. - The hotel is 6.7 miles from the airport, and 4 miles from Cornell University College of Veterinary Medicine.
